MiCMO November Meeting

Secretary Report - Year End MiCMO Meeting - November 19, 2011

Secretary's report was read. Katie Hatchett made first motion to accept it and Vicki Horsley seconded the motion.

Treasurer's report was read. Barb estimated 1500 dollars for awards. The MiCMO is in good shape financially. Barb suggested that we take 1 dollar of the 2 dollar MiCMO ride manager fee per rider to be split and 1 dollar would go to the club and the other dollar would go the non profit group associated with the group that maintains the trails for trail maintenance. Carolyn Wayman made a motion to accept and Linda Kraai seconded it. The club voted on it and it passed unanimously.

Treasurer's report was accepted by Bob Wager and Katie Hatchett seconded it.

Janet Wenger is writing articles about MiCMO for Saddle Up. Thank You Janet! Alison is going to get the address so our members can receive Saddle Up electronically. There is an ad available for 90 dollars which will give us info in every addition, black and white ad and ride schedule goes in for free. Kate Hatchett accepted it and Leigh Ann Nelson seconded it. The vote went through. Janet will requisition the article.

Alison expressed disappointment in the conduct the surrounded the last 2 rides. Many different issues happened and we need to make sure we are paying attention to the rules. Don't wait for complaints, and please bring them up as they happen. NACMO board is reviewing the phone policy currently so we will wait to see what they come up with. A phone should only be used in emergencies currently.

After these occurrences, we have put the following policy into effect for the 2012 ride season:

If a complaint stating a rule has been broken is brought before the MiCMO Board it will be discussed at length with all parties involved. If it is decided by the Board that the alleged complaint is valid the following will be implemented:

1st Offense: Warning letter from MiCMO board specific to the rule broken accompanied by a copy of the NACMO By-laws. NACMO Notified

2nd Offense: Warning letter from MiCMO board specific to the rule broken accompanied by a copy of the NACMO By-laws. NACMO Notified Disqualified from that days ride, no refund, no points.

3rd offense: Disqualified from that weekends ride, no refund, no points. Termination of MiCMO membership for that year.

Membership may be granted to the offender the following year on a probationary period. Any suspected violation of rules is grounds for termination of their membership indefinitely.

Katie Hatchett made the motion to accept this change and Vicki Horsley seconded it. The vote passed unanimously.

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There will be no fee to MiCMO to file a complaint. Motion was made by Chris Hubert and seconded by Vicki Horsley. The vote passed.

This policy is for the 2012 ride season. All 2011 occurrences are in the past and have been dealt with.

President's report was accepted by Vicki Horsley and seconded by Leigh Ann.

New Business:

Horse Expo is March 9-10-11 2012. MSU Pavilion, East Lansing, Michigan We need people to sign up. Cell phone numbers need to be put on list so everyone has them at the Expo. We are adding 2 passes. Leigh Ann accepted it and Katie seconded it. The vote passed.

Website updates need to be done with awards for 2011. Ride manager rules need to be posted on website.

There was a suggestion to add "I have read and agree to abide by the official rules."
The motion was made by Cindy Debiak and accepted by Cindy List. The vote passed if we can add this to registration form if okayed by NACMO.
